

ABOUT US

At the IHH Humanitarian Relief Foundation, since our establishment in 1992, we have been dedicated to providing essential humanitarian aid to those in desperate situations. Whether facing disasters, caught in the midst of war, impacted by natural calamities, or experiencing violence, we strive to prevent the violation of fundamental rights and freedoms worldwide. Our efforts began with volunteer work and became institutionalized in 1995. Over a short span, these endeavors expanded to 123 countries, establishing a charitable bridge from Türkiye to the entire world.

While carrying out its work in the fields of humanitarian relief, human rights and humanitarian diplomacy, IHH acts as a role model in the development of non-governmental organizations that operate in regions that suffer from unjust treatment, prioritizing the development of a sense of helping, solidarity and brotherhood both at home and abroad and has implemented several social and cultural projects for this purpose. In addition to its emergency relief efforts, IHH also builds permanent buildings such as schools, hospitals, cultural centers, mosques, water wells, orphanages and healthcare centers that will help the local people improve, and provides humanitarian diplomacy in all matters where interstate diplomacy is not able to produce a solution, acting as a mediator to solve such problems.

Honored with the Outstanding Service Award by the Turkish Grand National Assembly in 2007, the IHH Humanitarian Relief Foundation has been granted tax exemption, and classified as a foundation working for public benefit as per Cabinet Decree 2011/1799 of 04.04.2011. IHH received the "State Outstanding Sacrifice Medal and Badge" for its disaster management efforts in the earthquakes that happened in Kahramanmaras in 2023.

The IHH Humanitarian Relief Foundation is an advisory status member of the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) and the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC); a council member of the Organization for Islamic Cooperation Humanitarian Fund (OICHF), and a member of the Humanitarian Forum (THF); International Council of Voluntary Agencies (ICVA); Turkish Volunteer Organizations Foundation (TGTV), and the Union of NGOs of the Islamic World (IDSB) and the International Search and Rescue Consultancy Group within the United Nations (INSARAG).



It also provides training to NGOs at home and abroad, helping raise competent teams and getting communities prepared for disasters. The earthquakes in Kahramanmaraş on the 6th of February once again showed us how important all such efforts are. We established the Emergency Aid and Search & Rescue Unit in 2009 which has been continuing its works under IHH Disaster Management since 2020. The reason why we founded this unit was to carry out our efforts under an integrated disaster management system.


IHH Disaster Management is ready in 77 cities in our country to respond quickly and effectively to domestic and international disasters with 3,687 volunteering search and rescue technicians, 39 search and rescue vehicles and three search and rescue dogs that completed AFAD accreditation.

In order to test our capacity in this field and increase our field experience, we held national drills in Bursa in 2019 and Bolu in 2020. In addition, we carry out projects to meet all kinds of needs of disaster victims through our working groups that we established in accordance with the Turkish Disaster Intervention Plan (TAMP).

Our donors and volunteers are always here to help us save lives by responding to disasters as they are the most important stakeholders of our strong organization. Acting in a dedicated way to save a person's life, participating in training, drills and disaster intervention activities without expecting anything in return and trying to lessen the burden of others can only be made possible through volunteering.

In this report, you can examine the work done by our professional and volunteer teams in accordance with our vision and mission that we have summarized above as IHH Disaster Management. You can see the details of our domestic and international operations and training courses we held in 2023 in 77 cities.

I would like to express my endless gratitude to our philanthropists and volunteers who made it possible for us to perform all these works.



IHH DISASTER MANAGEMENT - SEARCH & RESCUE TEAMS

We have 12 teams in the **Marmara** region. Four of these teams also have the capacity to search and rescue under water. Our teams consist of 1,253 volunteer search & rescue technicians who have received search and rescue training in urban areas and nature.



We have 9 teams in the **Aegean** region. Our teams consist of 356 volunteer search & rescue technicians who have received search and rescue training in urban areas and nature.



We have 9 teams in the **Mediterranean** region. Three of these teams also have the capacity to search and rescue under water. Our teams consist of 372 volunteer search & rescue technicians who have received search and rescue training in urban areas and nature.



We have 12 teams in the Central **Anatolia** region. Three of these teams also have the capacity to search and rescue under water. Our teams consist of 529 volunteer search & rescue technicians who have received search and rescue training in urban areas and nature.



We have 18 teams in the **Black Sea** region. Three of these teams also have the capacity to search and rescue under water. Our teams consist of 563 volunteer search & rescue technicians who have received search and rescue training in urban areas and nature.









INTERNATIONAL OPERATIONS

Libya - Derna Flood

The flood caused by heavy rainfall following the major hurricane in Derna, Libya on September 9, 2023 caused great devastation in the region. According to authorities, there were more than 5,000 casualties and more than 20,000 missing cases.

As IHH Search and Rescue team, we arrived in the region with our team of 15 people together with other agencies and NGOs under the coordination of AFAD. During our week-long efforts, we reached the bodies of 23 people.







Morocco - Marrakech Earthquake

A magnitude 6.8 earthquake hit Morocco on September 8, 2023. It was reported that the earthquake occurred at a depth of 18.5 km with its center being the High-Atlas Mountains, 71 kilometers to the southwest of Marrakech. Marrakech, with a population of 840,000, was the most hit region by the earthquake. According to the reports, many houses collapsed in the city while many others had structural damage.

According to official figures, 2,946 people died and 5,674 people were injured in the earthquake. It was reported that the majority of the missing cases were in the cities of Al-Haouz and Taroudant. Upon a call by AFAD, our search and rescue team was made ready to leave for the region, but as the Moroccan Government only accepted search and rescue support from certain countries, our team went to the region for the coordination of investigation and humanitarian relief efforts, carrying out relief efforts for disaster victims for a week.

Afghanistan - Herat Earthquake

The 6.3 magnitude earthquake hit Herat, Afghanistan on October 7, 2023 at a depth of 7.7 km and caused destruction and damage in 30 villages in the district of Zendeh Jan, Herat. Following this earthquake, seven others with magnitudes above 5.0 occurred in the region. Three of these earthquakes had a magnitude of 6.3, one had a magnitude of 5.9, two had a magnitude of 5.5, and another one had a magnitude of 5.1.

Molla Canan Saik, Spokesperson for Afghanistan's State Ministry Responsible for Natural Disasters said in a statement on October 8 that a total of 1,320 houses collapsed in 30 villages and 2,445 people died while 2,440 were injured.

IHH Search and Rescue team arrived in the region for the coordination of investigation and humanitarian relief efforts and worked there for a week.
